- Register pupil attendance and supervise pupils during school hours and activities.
- Maintain records and reports on pupils' personal and social development.

- Regularly review teaching methods and curriculum planning.
- Engage fully in professional development opportunities.
- Participate in performance management and appraisal processes.
- Collaborate with the Assistant Head (Teaching & Learning) and colleagues to develop curriculum content, teaching materials, and pastoral strategies.
